OVERVIEW

The Marquee Ensemble, formerly known as the *MARQUEE Program*, is an annual professional and community arts enrichment program offered by <u>The Musical Stage Company</u>. Each year, program workshops and activities are designed in alignment with a production from that year's season with the aim of fostering new, meaningful connections to contemporary music theatre with local artists and audiences.

This year's *Marquee Ensemble* members can expect to participate in weekly theatre, dance, and music workshops, group discussions, facilitated independent creation and reflection time, personal presentations from the cast and creative team of **DIXON ROAD**, and creative, social opportunities to connect with fellow art-lovers and theatre arts professionals.

This year's program will be offered in person at the High Park Nature Centre, in both indoor and outdoor spaces, and in accordance with our COVID Health & Safety Policy. Program days are on all Sundays in June (2022), from 2 - 6 pm.

Participants ages 18 and older are welcome to apply. No experience in the arts is necessary, and varying levels of experience are warmly welcomed. Limited spots are available, with priority given to applicants that are available to attend all 4 sessions (June 5th, 12th, 19th & 26th).

We encourage applications from people who have felt previously uninvited to and unwelcome in music theatre spaces. We acknowledge that the practice of conventional musical theatre is often hostile to most cultural backgrounds, marginalized classes, abilities, identities and languages. We are looking forward to collaborating with participants to co-create a space that celebrates your lived experience, your histories, and your interests in music, dance, and theatre.
