


















Dillan graduated from Sheridan College's Musical Theatre program and has a Master's degree in Musical Theatre from The Royal Conservatoire of Scotland. He also teaches singing lessons at his old school of Sheridan in their Musical Theatre department. Dillan is the very first Indigenous singing teacher at Sheridan. Dillan has a passion for telling Indigenous stories from Turtle Island! This is Dillan's second time

participating in **ONE SONG GLORY**, and is thrilled to be back!
